

Assess and cleanup contamination at:

- Water Sources
- Abandoned Mines
- Former Mills

- Investigating impacts of mining and milling on the ground water.
- Public report and meetings in Fall 2017.
- Ground water information for use by regulatory agencies, stakeholders, and communities to guide their decision-making.



- \$985 million settlement to fund response at Kerr-McGee/Tronox Mines.
- Coordination between EPA, Navajo Nation, NMED, and NM-EMNRD-MMD.
- Determined extent of contamination on eastern and western areas of Ambrosia Lake and began the assessment of cleanup methods.
- Began assessment of contamination of central area of Ambrosia Lake.
- Time-Critical Removal Action to install Radon Abatement system at a residential structure.
