Purposefully Different

Undergraduate courses are available online & asynchronously. Residential sections are also available. We have **5 entry points** with **8- & 16-week options**. All major courses are offered each semester. Minor courses are offered 1-2X p/yr. **Graduate** courses are offered 2-3X p/yr., require synchronous attendance, and are available residentially and at a distance. One semester on campus is required. Part-time enrollment is permitted.
