

#### **Election Day is Nov. 8**

- GO Bond C will NOT raise taxes
- Includes \$27.5 million for NMSU campuses statewide
  - \$22.5 million for Dan Williams Hall
    - Houses NMSU's Art Department
    - Gymnasium built in 1938
    - \$800,000 in private funds already raised
  - \$1.5 million for NMSU Doña Ana
