At a duly called meeting of the Santa Clara Tribal Council on August 26, 2011 the council reviewed the concept with designated maps that are presented by the Native American Work Group on legislative redistricting. The concept specifically addresses the northwest quadrant of the state of New Mexico and those tribes within this quadrant. It also impacts tribes whose boundaries are adjacent to the Senate, House, Public Regulatory Commission, and Congressional districts that are proposed. It agrees and supports in principal the concept and designated boundaries. The Pueblo of Santa Clara also states that it chooses to remain in the following districts; with the condition that the percentage of Native Americans in each district reconfigured is not decreased:

- House District 41
- Senate District 5
- PRC District 3
- Congressional District 3

The Santa Clara Tribal council voted this date to support the Northwest quadrant redistricting concept. In addition, Santa Clara Pueblo makes an official declaration to the 2011 New Mexico redistricting legislature and Governor Suzanna Martinez that it expresses its sovereign authority to be placed in the above designated districts.
