DoIT ACT REVISIONS

- DoIT Act Revisions – Why?
 - Technology changes since inception of the Act
 - IT service needs have changed
 - Cloud
 - Software-as-a-service
 - Cyber threat landscape constantly changing
 - Information privacy and classification
 - Public record process limits controls
 - Lack of classification information controls
 - Federal grant dollars may not be accessible

RETENTION AND HIRING CHALLENGES

- Staff Augmentation needs
 - Support Enterprise Program
 - Cybersecurity (if hiring is not feasible)
- Challenges
 - Limited IT resource pool vs. demand
 - Time to hire
 - Compensation
 - Work-life balance

 - IT staffing and retention issues
 - Support state agency critical IT infrastructure
 - Foster interagency collaboration
 - Standardization of rules and processes
 - Billing transparency
 - Customer service
 - Help desk support

- Application education and training
 - Microsoft O365 tools
 - SHARE modules
- Expanding enterprise software offerings and support
 - Salesforce
 - IPRA Management
 - Record Management

- Service Level Agreements
 - Review other states best practices
 - Draft templates
- EPMO Modernization Project
 - Streamline processes (#1 Agency CIO priority)
 - EPMO Assessment
 - As-is and to-be
