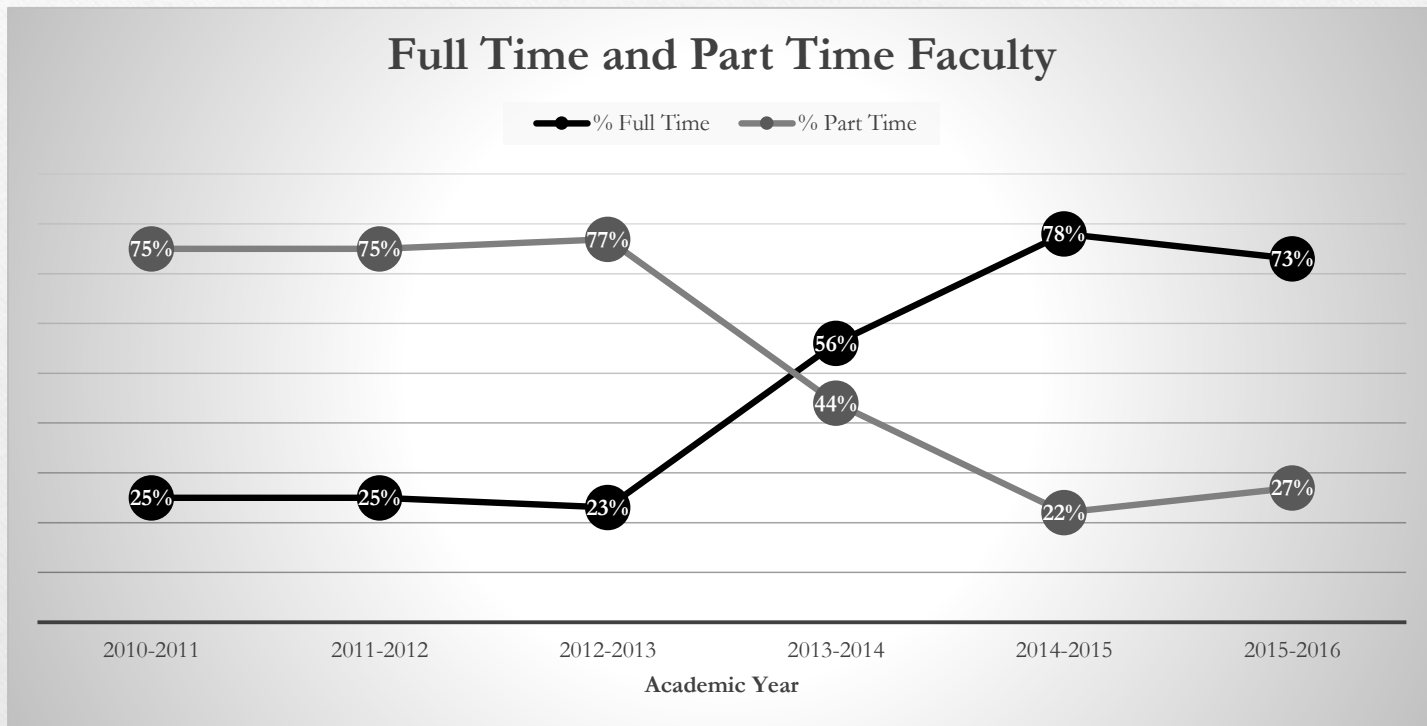


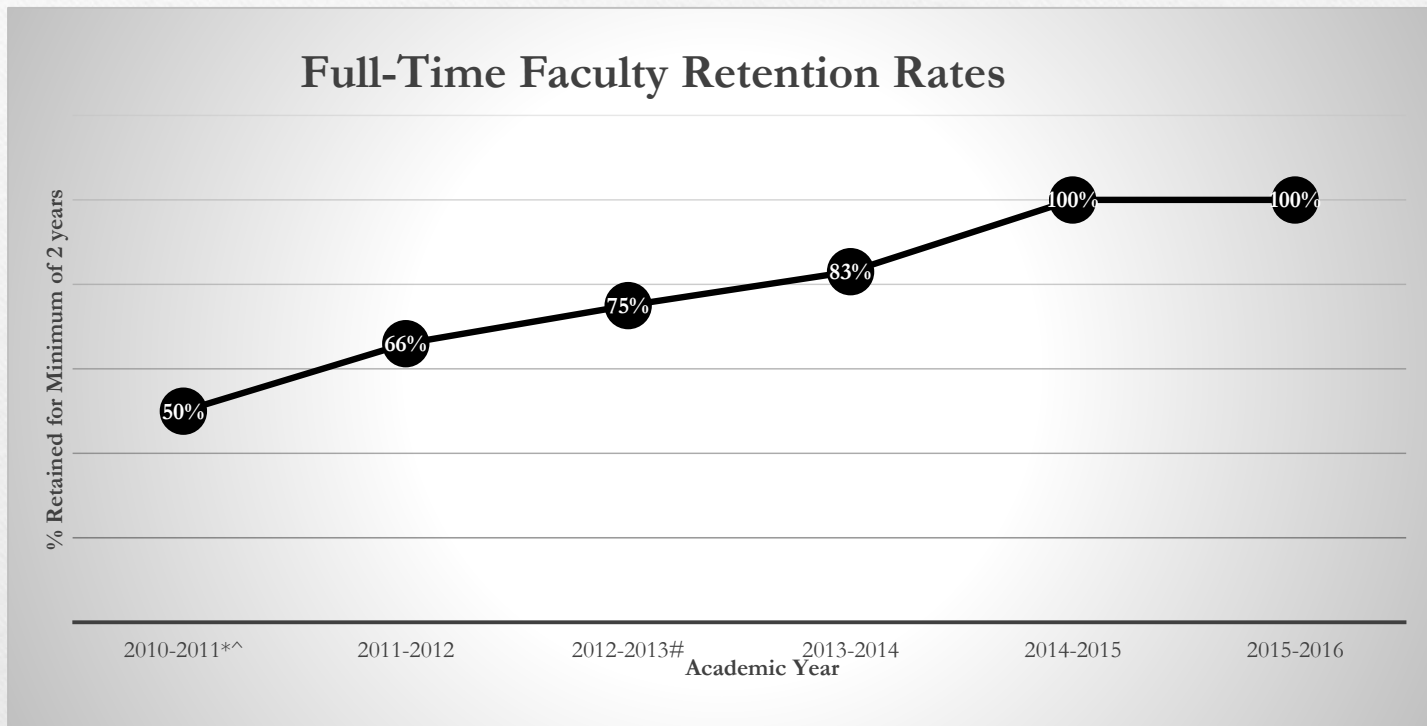

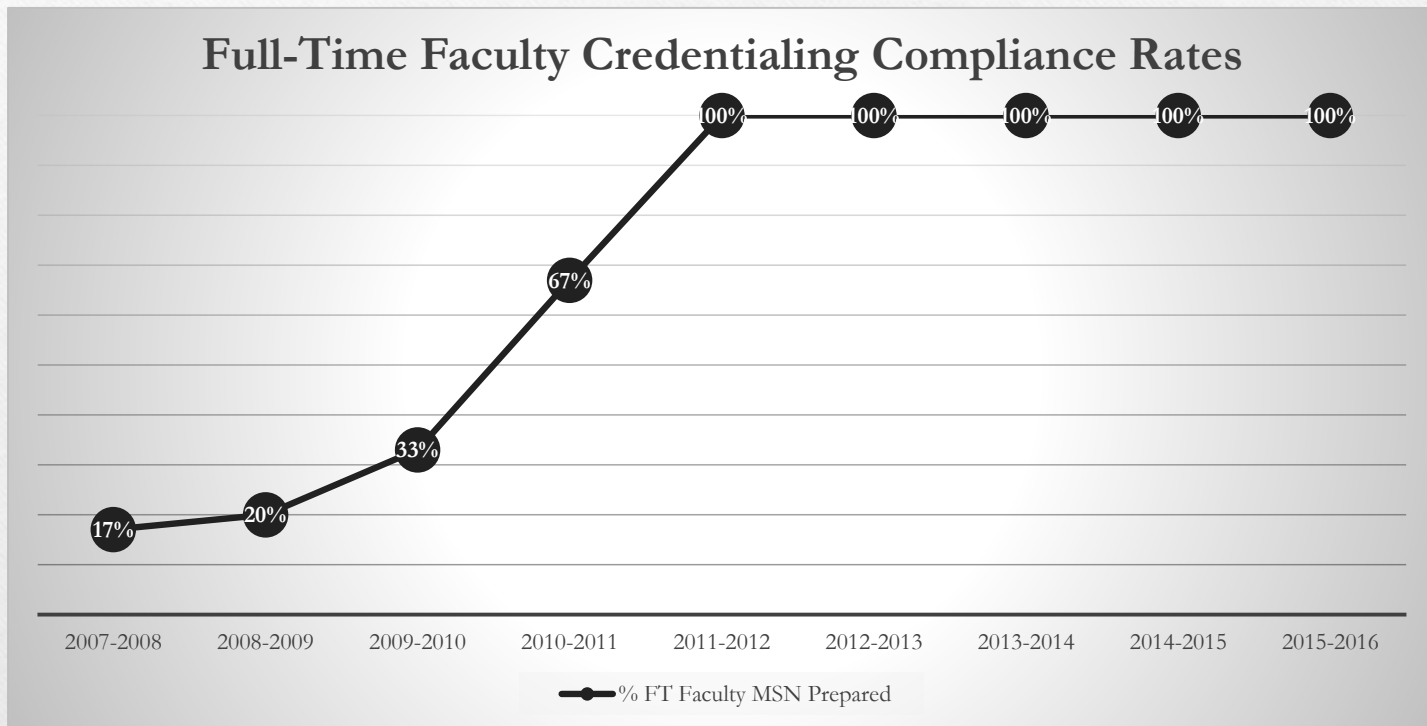
Program Update: Faculty Mix



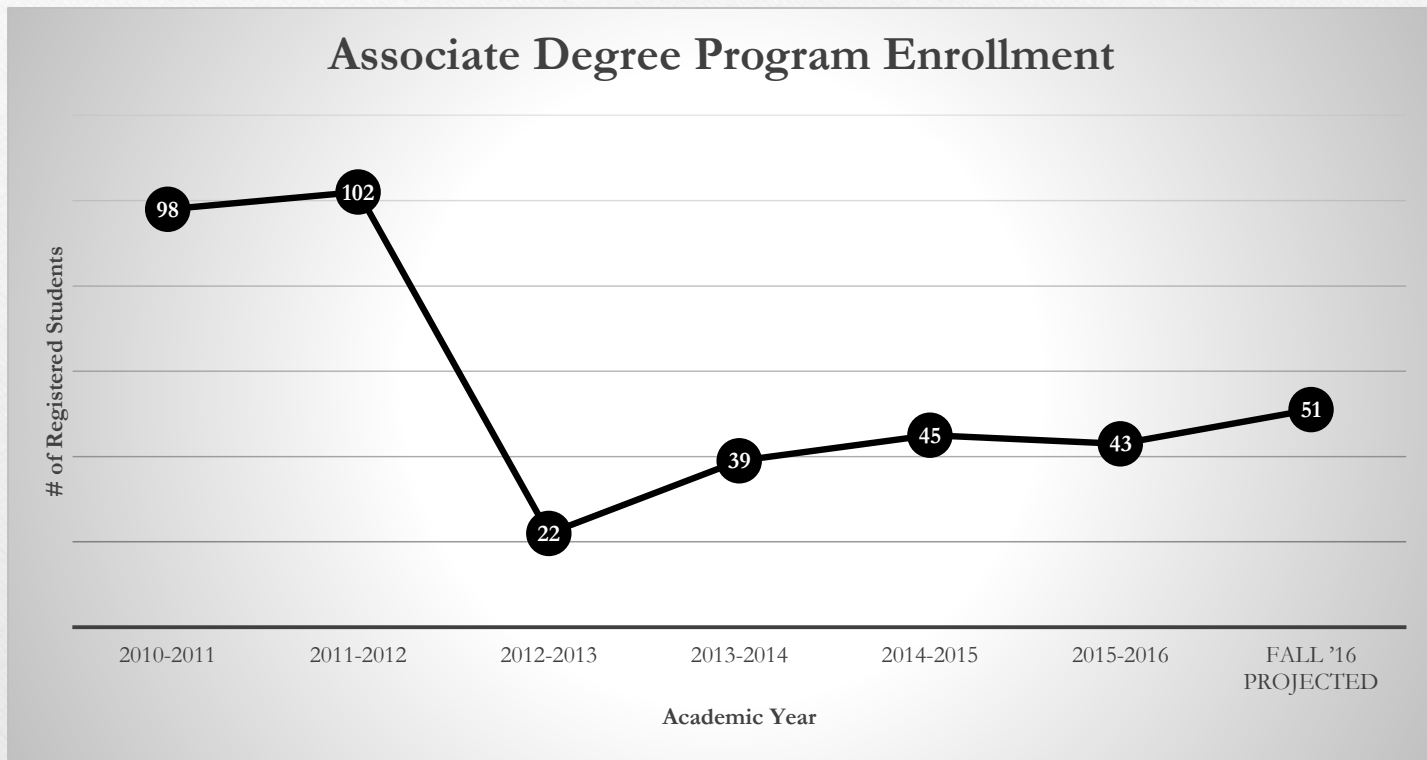
Program Update: Faculty Retention

Workforce Needs County/State

- LPN forecasted growth of 20% by 2025 (NMDOL, 2016); {28% nationally HRSA, 2016}
- RN forecasted growth of 16% by 2022 (NMDOL, 2016); {21% nationally HRSA, 2016}
- 43.8% of New Mexico RN's are >50 years old (NMBON, 2015)
- Average age of nursing faculty is >50 years old (AACN, 2015)
- Expected shortage of 86,000 RN's by 2025 (not accounting for impact of ACA)

Workforce Needs: Las Cruces

- In July there were 135 nursing positions open between 6 local facilities
- Average turnover at these facilities is 22.1%
- New freestanding Emergency Department being built
- New primary care clinic being built (La Clinica)
- New long term care facility planned in the next 5 years
