AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MASTER'S LEVEL PROGRAMS IN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY AND PHYSICAL THERAPY TO MEET INCREASING LICENSING REQUIREMENTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred ninety-eight thousand seven hundred dollars (\$198,700) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal years 2000 and 2001 for the purpose of converting existing undergraduate programs in occupational therapy and physical therapy to master's level programs in order to meet increased licensing education requirements. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the general fund.
