AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION  
TO SUPPORT A FACULTY TECHNOLOGY MENTOR PROGRAM AT PUBLIC TWO-  
YEAR POST-SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred sixty-four  
thousand dollars (\$164,000) is appropriated from the general  
fund to the commission on higher education for expenditure in  
fiscal year 2001 to support a faculty technology mentor  
program at public two-year post-secondary educational  
institutions statewide. Using the Albuquerque technical-  
vocational institute and San Juan college programs as models,  
selected faculty from each public two-year post-secondary  
educational institution may attend a summer and winter  
training institute to develop expertise in contextual  
learning, technology-enhanced instruction and distance

1 delivery of instruction. The faculty will be required to  
2 share their expertise with faculty on their respective  
3 campuses and with area public school teachers. Each public  
4 two-year post-secondary educational institution that receives  
5 funds for the program shall provide an equal amount of  
6 funding to match the state appropriation. Any unexpended or  
7 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001  
8 shall revert to the general fund.
