**44TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION,
2000**

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;
MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR ENERGY, MINERALS AND
NATURAL RESOURCES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS.--

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the
general fund to the energy, minerals and natural resources
department for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for the
following purposes:

(1) ninety-eight thousand five hundred
dollars (\$98,500) to the administrative services division for
operating expenses; and

(2) one million seven hundred eighty-four
thousand dollars (\$1,784,000) to the state parks division for
operating expenses.

1 B. The following amounts are appropriated from the
2 following funds to the state parks division of the energy,
3 minerals and natural resources department for expenditure in
4 fiscal year 2000 for operating expenses:

5 (1) one hundred sixty-two thousand five
6 hundred dollars (\$162,500) from cash balances in the state
7 parks division operating account;

8 (2) two hundred sixty-six thousand dollars
9 (\$266,000) from federal funds; and

10 (3) one million nine hundred ninety-eight
11 thousand six hundred dollars (\$1,998,600) from other revenue
12 deposited in the state parks division operating account, the
13 motorboat fuel tax fund and the energy, minerals and natural
14 resources department capital projects fund.

15 C. Three hundred fifty-five thousand two hundred
16 dollars (\$355,200) is appropriated from interagency transfers
17 of governmental gross receipts tax revenue of the energy,
18 minerals and natural resources department capital projects
19 fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2000 for maintenance and
20 upkeep at state parks.

21 D. Any unexpended or unencumbered balances
22 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert.

23 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
24 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
