AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO
CONTRACT FOR THE OPERATION OF A STATEWIDE PROGRAM CONDUCTED
BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT PROVIDES RECREATIONAL,
EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES FOR AT-RISK YOUTH AND
THEIR FAMILIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred seventy-five
thousand dollars (\$275,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the department of public safety for expenditure in
fiscal year 2001 for the purpose of contracting for the
operation of a statewide program conducted by a law
enforcement agency that provides recreational, educational
and cultural activities for at-risk youth and their families.
The program shall also be conducted for at-risk youth and
their families who reside on Indian reservations and pueblos.
