AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIAL BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT; MAKING  
AN APPROPRIATION FOR A SALARY INCREASE FOR JUSTICES, JUDGES  
AND MAGISTRATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION--SALARY INCREASE FOR JUSTICES,  
JUDGES AND MAGISTRATES.--Seven hundred thirteen thousand five  
hundred dollars (\$713,500) is appropriated from the general  
fund to the administrative office of the courts for the  
purpose of providing the justices of the supreme court a  
salary increase to ninety-eight thousand dollars (\$98,000)  
and the chief justice of the supreme court, the chief judge  
of the court of appeals, judges of the court of appeals,  
district courts and metropolitan courts and magistrates a  
salary increase pursuant to Section 34-1-9 NMSA 1978. The  
salary increases pursuant to this section shall be effective
