Each director, with the consent of the chief of 6 staff, shall employ such professional, technical and support 7 staff as necessary to carry out the duties of his division. 8 Employees shall be hired solely on the ground of their 9 fitness to perform the job for which they are hired. <u>Except</u> 10 as provided in Subsection D of this section, division staff 11 are subject to the provisions of the Personnel Act.

D. With the consent of the chief of staff, the superintendent of insurance may designate the following insurance division positions as exempt from the provisions of the Personnel Act: hearing examiners, deputy

superintendents, chief actuaries and bureau chiefs."

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
