This bill carries an emergency clause. Significant Issues Taos received a non-recurring appropriation for this purpose for FY00. FISCAL IMPLICATIONS The appropriation of \$300.0 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund for expenditure in fiscal years 2000 and 2001. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY01 shall revert to the general fund. OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES According to the CHE, eighteen additional community colleges statewide are similar in mission to the Taos off-campus center, but none receive non-formula adjustments for manpower development and training programs. The CHE recommends that the following language be included for all new recurring higher education
