ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS	

The Corrections Department suggests that the funds appropriated will be used to contract with two

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counselors and compensate the contractors for their time and travel. Also some of the appropriation will be used to obtain materials required for sweat lodge ceremonies.

The Department maintains that the enactment of this bill could reduce the administrative burden of prison administrators who struggle to obtain Native American spiritual counselors on a volunteer basis.

Any administrative burden for procurement staff who will be required to contract for these services could be absorb by the Department.
