WHEREAS, an estimated twenty-five thousand New Mexicans and six million Americans took the drugs Fen-Phen/Redux; and

WHEREAS, these diet drugs have been found to cause heart damage and other injuries, and New Mexicans were not warned of the dangers of the drugs; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico has an interest in preserving the safety, health and welfare of its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the department of health, the board of pharmacy and the attorney general be requested to investigate the activities of Wyeth home products in its failure to warn New Mexicans of the
