HOUSE BILL 29

**44TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - 2ND SPECIAL SESSION, 2000**

AN ACT

MAKING GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES BY  
STATE AGENCIES REQUIRED BY LAW; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SPECIAL FISCAL YEAR 2000 AND 2001

APPROPRIATIONS.--The following amounts are appropriated from  
the general fund or other funds as indicated for the purposes  
specified. Unless otherwise indicated, the appropriations may  
be expended in fiscal years 2000 and 2001. Unless otherwise  
indicated, any unexpended or unencumbered balance of the  
appropriations remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall  
revert to the appropriate fund:

A. seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) is  
appropriated from the general fund to the organic commodity  
commission for operating expenses;

B. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is  
appropriated from the general fund to the tourism department  
for advertising; and

C. the following amounts are appropriated from the

1 general fund to the economic development department for the  
2 following purposes:

3 (1) one hundred ten thousand dollars  
4 (\$110,000) for the Arizona, Colorado and New Mexico Smithsonian  
5 exhibit on the Rio Grande; and

6 (2) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000)  
7 for project uplift.

8 Section 2. SPECIAL FISCAL YEAR 2001 APPROPRIATIONS.--The  
9 following amounts are appropriated from the general fund or  
10 other funds as indicated for the purposes specified. Unless  
11 otherwise indicated, the appropriations may be expended in  
12 fiscal year 2001. Unless otherwise indicated, any unexpended  
13 or unencumbered balance of the appropriations remaining at the  
14 end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the appropriate fund:

15 A. one hundred thirty-six thousand dollars  
16 (\$136,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the supreme  
17 court law library for the westlaw contract;

18 B. one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000)  
19 is appropriated from the general fund to the magistrate courts  
20 of the administrative office of the courts for three permanent  
21 full-time equivalent clerks;

22 C. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars  
23 (\$175,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the second  
24 judicial district attorney for grand jury costs for re-  
25 indictments;

D. twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$27,000) is  
appropriated from the general fund to the state auditor for  
rent increases;

E. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated

1 from the general fund to the local government division of the  
2 department of finance and administration for the purpose of  
3 providing services to at-risk children at the Dona Ana county  
4 educational camp and recreational park as a pilot program for  
5 similar program services statewide;

6 F. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) is  
7 appropriated from the general fund to the public defender  
8 department for costs associated with grand jury re-indictments  
9 in Bernalillo county;

10 G. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is  
11 appropriated from the general fund to the tourism department  
12 for advertising;

13 H. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars  
14 (\$175,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office  
15 of cultural affairs for the route 66 celebration;

16 I. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is  
17 appropriated from the general fund to the Hispanic cultural  
18 division of the office of cultural affairs for events related  
19 to the opening and dedication of the Hispanic cultural center;

20 J. twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) is  
21 appropriated from the general fund and twenty-four thousand  
22 dollars (\$24,000) is appropriated from federal funds to the New  
23 Mexico livestock board for an additional meat inspector;

24 K. seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) is  
25 appropriated from the general fund from the general fund to the  
organic commodity commission for operations;

L. the following amounts are appropriated from the  
general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for the  
following purposes:

1 (1) twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for  
2 the purpose of facilitating water rights negotiations between  
3 the Navajo Nation and the state;

4 (2) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to fund  
5 an informational process, develop basic provisions and complete  
6 intergovernmental agreements pursuant to Section 32A-1-8 NMSA  
7 1978 between the children, youth and families department and  
8 tribes interested in entering into agreements with the state;

9 (3) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for a  
10 development officer in Crownpoint to assist with planning and  
11 implementing capital projects; and

12 (4) eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to  
13 contract for the provision of domestic violence and parents  
14 intervention program services in Crownpoint;

15 M. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) is  
16 appropriated from the general fund to the department of health  
17 to contract for provision of substance abuse outpatient  
18 treatment services in the southeastern area of McKinley county;

19 N. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated  
20 from the general fund to the children, youth and families  
21 department for medicaid ineligible youth programs;

22 O. thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$38,000) is  
23 appropriated from the general fund to the corrections  
24 department for a prison visitation facility at the female  
25 facility in Grants;

P. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars  
(\$175,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the crime  
victims reparation commission for domestic violence against  
women programs;

1 Q. the following amounts are appropriated from the  
2 general fund to the state department of public education for  
3 the following purposes:

4 (1) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the  
5 center for civic values mock trial program; and

6 (2) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to  
7 expand service learning initiatives;

8 R. the following amounts are appropriated from the  
9 general fund to the university of New Mexico for the following  
10 purposes:

11 (1) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to expand  
12 the base of funding for the existing New Mexico resource  
13 geographic information system program at the university of New  
14 Mexico; additional resource geographic information system  
15 responsibilities will include staff to support the geographic  
16 information system advisory committee and related geographic  
17 information system activities, advancing the goals of the  
18 information technology commission;

19 (2) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for  
20 housing and support services for cancer patients and their  
21 families in Albuquerque; and

22 (3) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000)  
23 for scholarships for international students from Latin America  
24 to attend the university;

25 S. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is  
appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico department  
of agriculture for acequias;

T. the following amounts are appropriated from the  
general fund to New Mexico state university for the following

1 purposes:

2 (1) twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for  
3 a dental assistance program at the Dona Ana branch; and

4 (2) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to  
5 increase women's sports activities to comply with Title 9 of  
6 the federal Education Amendments of 1972;

7 U. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is  
8 appropriated from the general fund to western New Mexico  
9 university to increase women's sports activities to comply with  
10 Title 9 of the federal Education Amendments of 1972;

11 V. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is  
12 appropriated from the general fund to eastern New Mexico  
13 university for a mathematics, engineering and science program  
14 for high school students;

15 W. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) is  
16 appropriated from the general fund to Santa Fe community  
17 college for small business development centers; and

18 X. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated  
19 from the general fund to San Juan college for a dental  
20 assistance program at the college.

21 Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
22 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
