AN ACT

**RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES; PROHIBITING CERTAIN
SALES BY A LICENSEE; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE LIQUOR CONTROL
ACT.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. Section 60-7A-22 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1981,
Chapter 39, Section 108, as amended) is amended to read:**

**"60-7A-22. DRINKING IN PUBLIC ESTABLISHMENTS--SELLING OR
SERVING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OTHER THAN IN LICENSED
ESTABLISHMENTS--SELLING OR DELIVERING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM
A DRIVE-UP WINDOW. --**

**A. It is a violation of the Liquor Control Act for
any person to consume alcoholic beverages in any public
establishment unless the establishment is licensed to sell and
serve alcoholic beverages.**

B. It is a violation of the Liquor Control Act for any person not a licensee to sell, serve or permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages in his public establishment or private club.

C. It is a violation of the Liquor Control Act for any licensee to sell or deliver alcoholic beverages from a drive-up window or to sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to a customer, receive cash for a sale or locate a cash register within ten feet of an exterior door of the licensed premises. "

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2001.
