AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL  
REGISTRATION PLATES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of Chapter 66, Article 3 NMSA  
1978 is enacted to read:

" [NEW MATERIAL] SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES. --

A. The division shall establish and issue a  
special registration plate featuring artwork designed by the  
grand lodge of ancient free and accepted Masons of New Mexico  
and shall adopt procedures for application for and issuance of  
the special Mason's registration plate and plates for the  
Elks, Moose, Eagles and Sertoma lodges.

B. An owner of a motor vehicle who is a member of  
a fraternal lodge identified in Subsection A of this section

1 may apply for the issuance of a special registration plate for  
2 a fee of forty dollars (\$40.00), in addition to the regular  
3 motor vehicle registration fees. The owner of a motor vehicle  
4 shall apply and pay a fee each year that he wishes to retain  
5 and renew his special registration plate.

6 C. The revenue from the special registration  
7 plates shall be distributed as follows:

8 (1) fifteen dollars (\$15.00) of the fee  
9 collected for each registration plate shall be retained by the  
10 division in fiscal years 2002 and 2003 and is appropriated to  
11 the division for the manufacture and issuance of the  
12 registration plates. Thereafter, that amount of each fee  
13 shall be paid to the state treasurer for credit to the motor  
14 vehicle suspense fund for distribution in accordance with  
15 Section 66-6-23 NMSA 1978; and

16 (2) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) of the fee  
17 collected for each registration plate shall be distributed to  
18 the board of regents of the university of New Mexico hospital  
19 leukemia/cancer unit. "
