SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 738 amends the Clean Indoor Act to prohibit smoking in the State Capitol's private offices, House and Senate Lounges, and in the Capitol North.

SDE indicates the State Capitol and Capitol North are the only state public buildings that still allow smoking.
