SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

This bill appropriates \$242,000 to the Department of Health to provide services in the south Broadway area of Albuquerque focusing on daytime school for dropouts, a critical hours program during evenings for children in the juvenile justice system and a job training program.

Significant Issues

CYFD wrote that the Health Department does not typically fund programs in the educational field. They also noted that there may be a possible conflict with Albuquerque Public Schools and with the State Department of Education concerning standard educational regulations with curriculum and accreditation.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This bill appropriates \$242,000 from the general fund to the Health Department for at-risk youth in the south Broadway area of Albuquerque.
