## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$13,958.4 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the New Mexico State Fair fund. The Fair is an enterprise agency and any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY02 do not revert to the general fund but require appropriation by the Legislature each fiscal year.
