WHEREAS, J oe worked at Sandia national I aboratories for twenty years until his retirement, whereupon he began to work for the New Mexi co legi slature in 1988 and continued working for each legislative session until his death in November 2000; and

WHEREAS, al though J oe was a very qui et and modest person, he was very caring and had a uni que sense of humor and a little wry smile that al ways kept peopl e guessing, trying to figure hi mout; and

WHEREAS, J oe was positive about every situation that care hi s way and never had a bad word to say about anyone he met, i ncl uding Republ i cans!;
