A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO BY DELETING
THE REFERENCE TO THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED WEAPONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend the constitution of
New Mexico by amending Article 2, Section 6 to read:

"No law shall abridge the right of the citizen to keep and
bear arms for security and defense, for lawful hunting and
recreational use and for other lawful purposes [~~but nothing~~
~~herein shall be held to permit~~]. The carrying of concealed
weapons shall be permitted or regulated as provided by law. No
municipality or county shall regulate, in any way, an incident
of the right to keep and bear arms."

Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
