AN ACT

**RELATING TO CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING; ESTABLISHING
CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVES TO
THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS; CHANGING A PROVISION OF THE
ELECTION CODE RELATING TO PRECINCTS; AMENDING, REPEALING AND
ENACTING SECTIONS OF THE NMSA 1978.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. Section 1-15-16 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1991
(1st S.S.), Chapter 7, Section 1) is repealed and a new
Section 1-15-16 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:**

**"1-15-16. [NEW MATERIAL] UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE--

2 "1-15-16. 1. PRECINCTS. --

3 A. Precinct designations and boundaries used in
4 the ~~[1991]~~ 2001 congressional redistricting are those precinct
5 designations and boundaries established pursuant to the
6 Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act and revised and approved
7 pursuant to that act by the secretary of state as of ~~[August~~
8 ~~16, 1991]~~ August 31, 2001.

9 B. ~~[The boards]~~ A board of county commissioners
10 shall not create any precinct that lies in more than one
11 congressional district ~~[nor]~~ and shall ~~[the boards of county~~
12 ~~commissioners]~~ not divide any precinct so that the divided
13 parts of the precinct are situated in two or more
14 congressional districts. Votes cast in ~~[any general, primary~~
15 ~~or other]~~ a statewide election from precincts created or
16 divided in violation of this subsection shall be invalid and
17 shall not be counted or canvassed. "
