## A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT TO SUPPORT
THE AMATEUR INTERNATIONAL SPORTS EDUCATIONAL FEDERATION AND

Bill Richardson has said that encouraging and promoting
sports activities, educational programs and attractive goals
to strive for with international recognition are key
elements to a tremendous positive lifestyle;
