16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. Section 60-2E-28 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,
18	Chapter 190, Section 30) is amended to read:
19	"60-2E-28. GAMING OPERATOR LICENSEESSPECIAL CONDITIONS
20	FOR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONSNUMBER OF GAMING MACHINESDAYS
21	AND HOURS OF OPERATIONS
22	A. A nonprofit organization may be issued a gaming
23	operator's license to operate licensed gaming machines on its
24	premises to be played only by active and auxiliary members.
25	B. No more than fifteen gaming machines may be

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offered for play on the premises of a nonprofit organization gaming operator licensee.

- C. No gaming machine on the premises of a nonprofit organization gaming operator licensee may award a prize that exceeds four thousand dollars (\$4,000).
- D. Gaming machines may be played on the premises of a nonprofit organization gaming operator licensee from 12:00 noon until 12:00 midnight every day.
- [E. Alcoholic beverages shall not be sold, served, delivered or consumed in the area where gaming machines are installed and operated on the premises of a nonprofit organization gaming operator licensee.]"
- Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
