VENDING MACHINES--RESTRICTIONS ON SALES OF 20 TOBACCO PRODUCTS. - -21 Except as provided in Subsections B and C of 22 this section: 23 (1) no person shall sell tobacco products at 24 a retail location in New Mexico by any means other than a 25

direct, face-to-face exchange between the customer and the

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- (2) no person selling goods at a retail location in New Mexico shall use a self-service display for tobacco products. For purposes of this subsection, "selfservice display" means a display to which the public has access without the assistance of the seller or the seller's employee.
- Tobacco products may be sold by vending В. machines in the following locations only:
- in locations not held open to the public, (1) including controlled areas within factories, businesses and offices; or
- in age-controlled locations where minors are not permitted unless accompanied by a parent or guardian [or
- (3) in locations where alcoholic beverages are offered for sale for the purpose of consumption on the premi ses].
- C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to written, telephone or electronic sales, including sales by mail order, fax machine or the internet."
- EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the Section 2. provisions of this act is January 1, 2003.

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
