SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 390 appropriates \$600.0 from the general fund to Department of Game and Fish for the purpose of acquiring water rights for habitat improvements in the Mimbres Valley in Grant county.

Significant Issues

The department states that the appropriation could be used to increase water storage capability within Bear Canyon Lake. There could be an opportunity to purchase the water rights with available cash balance in the Game Protection Fund. A reconciliation of this fund is shown below:
