### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 15 requests the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department to conduct a study of Ft. Bayard medical center to determine if it should be designated a state park.

# Significant Issues

The memorial states:

- 1. State parks enhance the beauty, culture economy and quality of life;
- 2. It is important to preserve the historical heritage of New Mexico;
- 3. The Ft. Bayard medical center is an historical building worthy of preserving:
- 4. A study is needed to collect more information on the Ft. Bayard medical center in order to determine if designating it a state park is the best method of preserving it; and
- 5. A copy of the memorial be sent to the secretary of energy, minerals and natural resources.

The memorial does not specify a timeline for the determination of state park status.
