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16	WHEREAS, changes in the nature of the life insurance
17	industry, in the acquisition of domestic companies by foreign
18	interests, in the elimination or reduction of the agent
19	workforce and in the activities of certain companies in the
20	maintenance and operation of their businesses have all
21	compromised fiduciary obligations to policyholders and the
22	financial integrity of policies; and
23	WHEREAS, insurance is virtually unregulated nationally
24	and what regulation there is, is on the state level; and
25	WHEREAS, there is no requirement within the New Mexico

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Insurance Code to direct regulated insurance companies to inform the superintendent of insurance of pending complaint actions in other states or other venues, including class action suits or regulatory or legal sanctions; and

WHEREAS, that requirement alone would foster increased awareness of these actions and their resolutions and provide the superintendent of insurance with a greater knowledge of national trends and an enhanced ability to spot conduct harmful to New Mexico policyholders and to join in causes of action in other states; and

WHEREAS, insurance activities in New Mexico generate over one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) of revenue for the state and are vital for the security of risk management of those they represent, including the financial future of families, individuals and businesses; and

WHEREAS, these issues are of vital interest to the legislature;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the public regulation commission, the superintendent of insurance and the attorney general be requested to review the New Mexico Insurance Code and recommend changes to improve insurance protection in New Mexico and report to the appropriate interim committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the public regulation commissioners, the .141266.3

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
