| 16 | Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 7, Section 5 |
| 17 | of the constitution of New Mexico to read: |
| 18 | " <u>A.</u> All elections shall be by ballot [and]. The |
| 19 | person who receives the highest number of votes for any |
| 20 | office, <u>except as provided in Subsection B of this section</u> , |
| 21 | and except in the cases of the offices of governor and |
| 22 | lieutenant governor, shall be declared elected [thereto] to |
| 23 | that office. The joint candidates receiving the highest |
| 24 | number of votes for the offices of governor and lieutenant |
| 25 | governor shall be declared elected to those offices. |
| | B. In a municipal election, the candidate who |
| | receives the highest number of votes for an office shall be |
| | declared elected to that office, unless the municipality |
| | provides for runoff elections. A municipality may provide for |
| | <u>runoff elections as follows:</u> |
