5 WHEREAS, the internet provides the potential for improved

7 sectors, encouraging increased business formation in the state
8 as well as increased tourism; and

9 WHEREAS, the ability to develop a highly effective level
10 of communication and connectedness is a worthy, cost-effective
11 and attainable objective;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
13 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the chief information officer, in
14 conjunction with the information technology oversight committee
15 and the office of the governor, create, within the information
16 technology management office, the center for life enhancement
17 that will be charged with the responsibility to provide a new
18 level of digital connectedness for state and local agencies to
19 deliver services to their constituencies and that will provide
20 users with knowledge, training and communications systems to
21 facilitate the work of state agencies and enhance economic
22 development activities; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
