2	(1) enrolled in or accepted by an
3	undergraduate or graduate teacher preparation program at a
4	regionally accredited post-secondary educational institution in
5	New Mexico;
6	<u>(2) a high school student who signs an</u>
7	agreement declaring his intent to serve as a public school
8	<u>teacher in a designated shortage area in New Mexico through a</u>
9	<u>career pathway program previous to enrollment in any two- or</u>
10	four-year teacher education program; or
11	(3) a student enrolled in a two-year
12	institution who, previous to enrollment in any teacher
13	education program, signs an agreement declaring his intent to
14	serve as public school teacher in a designated shortage area in
