- 7. On page 3, line 1, after "taxpayer's" insert "modified combined tax liability, personal income tax liability or".
- 8. On page 3, lines 8 and 9, strike "The state engineer shall not require a permit" and insert in lieu thereof "No permit shall be required from the state engineer".
- 9. On page 3, line 9, strike "disposed of"., and thence referred to the **TAXATION AND REVENUE COMMITTEE.**
