for a definite term of eighteen months or, in the discretion of the sentencing court, to a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or both.

B. Any person who trains, practices or receives instruction in the use of any firearm, destructive device or technique capable of causing injury or death to any person with the intent that the knowledge or skill taught, demonstrated or gained be unlawfully used in furtherance of a civil disorder is guilty of a fourth degree felony and shall be sentenced under the provisions of the Criminal Sentencing Act to imprisonment for a definite term of eighteen months or, in the discretion of the sentencing court, to a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or both.

<u>C. Any person who commits trespass on agricultural</u> <u>land or facilities to contaminate, threaten or destroy the food</u> <u>supply or disrupt agricultural operations to cause public fear</u> <u>is guilty of a fourth degree felony and shall be sentenced</u> <u>under the provisions of the Criminal Sentencing Act to</u> <u>imprisonment for a definite term of eighteen months or, in the</u> <u>discretion of the sentencing court, to a fine of not more than</u> <u>five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both.</u>"
