RELATI NG TO VEHI CLE REGI STRATI ON; UPDATI NG VETERANS SPECI ALTY PLATES; MDDI FYI NG THE REQUI REMENTS FOR STANDARDI ZED SPECI AL REG STRATI ON PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. Section 66-3-412. 1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2001, Chapter 243, Section 1) is amended to read:
" 66-3-412. 1. SPECI AL MOTORCYCLE REGI STRATI ON PLATES FOR ARMED FORCES VETERANS. -
A. The department shall issue di stinctive not orcycle regi stration pl ates indicating that the reci pient is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, as defined in Section 28-13-7 NMSA 1978, or is retired fromthe national guard or military reserves, if that person submits proof satisfactory to the department of honorable di scharge fromthe . 149484. 1
armed forces or of retirement fromthe national guard or military reserves.
B. For a fee of seven dollars (\$7.00), whi ch shal I be in addition to the regul ar mot orcycle regi stration fees, any mot orcycle owner who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States or is retired fromthe national guard or military reserves may apply for the issuance of a special motorcycle regi stration pl ate as defined in Subsection $A$ of $\mathrm{thi} s$ section. No two owners shall be issued identically lettered or numbered pl at es.
C. An owner shall make a new application and pay a new fee each year he desires to obtain a special motorcycle regi stration pl ate. He will have first priority on that plate for each subsequent year that he makes a timely and appropriate appl i cation.
D. Each armed forces veteran may el ect to recei ve a veteran- desi gnation decal to be pl aced across the top of the special motorcycle regi stration pl ate, centered above the regi stration number. Repl acement or different veterandesi gnation decals shall be available for purchase from the department at a reasonable charge to be set by the secretary. The department shall furnish the following veteran- desi gnation decals with the armed forces veteran motorcycle registration pl ate to a:
(1) nedal of honor reci pient;
(2) silver star reci pi ent;
(3) bronze star reci pi ent;
(4) navy cross reci pi ent ;
(5) di sti ngui shed servi ce cross reci pi ent;
(6) ai $r$ force cross reci pi ent;
(7) ex-prisoner of war;
(8) di sabl ed vet er an;
(9) purple heart veteran;
(10) at omi c vet er an;
(11) Pearl Harbor survi vor;
(12) Navaj o code tal ker;
(13) Vi et nam vet er an;
(14) Korean vet eran;
(15) di sabl ed Korean vet er an;
(16) Wbrld War II veteran;
(17) Wbrld War I veteran;
(18) Grenada vet er an;
(19) Panama veteran; [ өf]
(20) Desert St or m vet er an;
(21) Somal i a veteran;
(22) Af ghani stan veteran;
(23) Bosni a veteran; or
(24) I raqi Freedom vet er an.
E. The revenue fromthe fee imposed pursuant to
Subsection B of this section shall be retai ned by the 149484. 1
department and is appropriated to the department for the manufacture and issuance of the special motorcycle regi stration pl ates for armed forces veterans."

Section 2. Section 66-3-419 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 1990, Chapter 46, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
"66-3-419. SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES FOR ARMED FORCES VETERANS. - -
A. The department shall issue di stinctive regi stration pl ates indicating that the recipient is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, as defined in Section 28-13-7 NMSA 1978, or is retired fromthe national guard or military reserves, if that person submits proof satisfactory to the department of honorable discharge fromthe armed forces or of retirement fromthe national guard or military reserves.
B. For a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), whi ch shall be in addition to the regul ar motor vehicle registration fees, any motor vehi cle owner who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States or is retired fromthe national guard or military reserves may apply for the issuance of a special registration plate as defined in Subsection $A$ of $t h i s$ section. No two owners shall be issued identically lettered or numbered pl ates.
C. The fifteen- dollar (\$15.00) fee provi ded in

Subsection B of this section shall be wai ved for each regi stration period in whi ch a validating sticker is issued 149484. 1
under the provi si ons of Section 66-3-17 NMSA 1978, in lieu of the issuance of a special armed forces veteran plate.
D. Each armed forces veteran may el ect to recei ve a veteran- desi gnation decal to be pl aced across the top of the pl ate, centered above the registration number. Repl acement or different veteran-desi gnation decal s shall be available for purchase from the department at a reasonable charge to be set by the secretary. The department shall furni sh the following veteran- desi gnation decals with the armed forces veteran plate to a:
(1) medal of honor reci pient;
(2) sil ver star reci pient;
(3) bronze star reci pient;
(4) navy cross reci pi ent ;
(5) di sti ngui shed service cross reci pient;
(6) air force cross reci pient;
(7) ex-prisoner of war;
(8) di sabl ed veteran;
(9) purple heart veteran;
(10) atomic veteran;
(11) Pearl Harbor survi vor;
(12) Navajo code tal ker;
(13) Vi et nam vet er an;
(14) Korean veteran;
(15) di sabl ed Korean veteran;
(16) Wbrld War II veteran;
(17) Wbrld War I veteran;
(18) Grenada veter an;
(19) Panamæ vet er an; [ or]
(20) Desert St orm vet er an;
(21) Somal i a veteran;
(22) Af ghani st an veter an;
(23) Bosni a veteran; or
(24) I raqi Freedom vet er an.
E. The revenue fromthe special regi stration pl ates for the armed forces veterans fee imposed by Subsection B of thi s section shall be di stributed as follows:
(1) seven dollars (\$7.00) of the fee collected for each registration pl ate shall be retained by the department and is appropriated to the department for the manufacture and issuance of the registration pl ates; and
(2) ei ght dollars (\$8.00) of the fee collected for each regi stration pl ate shall be transferred pursuant to the provi si ons of Subsection $F$ of $t$ hi s section.
F. There is created in the state treasury the "armed forces veterans license fund". A portion of the fee collected for each special regi stration plate for armed forces veterans, as provi ded in Subsection E of this section, shall be transferred to the state treasurer for the credit of the fund. Expenditures fromthe fund shall be made on vouchers issued and . 149484. 1
si gned by the di rector of veterans' affairs upon warrants drawn by the department of finance and administration for the purpose of expanding services to rural areas of the state, incl uding Native Ameri can communities and seni or citizen centers. Any unexpended or unencumbered bal ance remai ning at the end of any fiscal year in the armed forces veterans license fund shall not revert to the general fund."

Section 3. Section 66-3-424 NMEA 1978 (bei ng Laws 2003, Chapter 172, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 174, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 175, Secti on 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 176, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 177, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 178, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 179, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 180, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 181, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 197, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 198, Secti on 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 201, Section 1 and Laws 2003, Chapter 211, Section 1 and al so Laws 2003, Chapter 212, Section 1) is amended to read:
" 66-3-424. STANDARDI ZED SPECI AL REGI STRATI ON PLATES WTH LOGOS. - -
A. Standardized special registration ates with I ogos may be authorized by stat ute to show state support for worthy public purposes. The authorizing stat ute shall provide for collection of fees that, at a mi num will cover the costs to the di visi on of devel opment, manuf act ure and issuance of the special regi stration pl ates and Iogos.
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B. Standardized speci al regi stration pl ates, on the st andar di zed areas, shall:
(1) di spl ay the col ors of the state flag, red lettering on a yellow or bl ue background;
(2) di spl ay the phrases "New Mexi co USA" and "Land of Enchant ment";
(3) provi de a space for appl ying the speci al regi stration logo, centered at the left edge of the plate, bet ween the attachment hol es, begi nning one-fourth inch in from the edge of the plate and having the following di mensions: four and one- ei ghth inches in hei ght and three and one- ei ghth inches in width; and
(4) provi de a vehicle regi stration number, to be assi gned by the di vision, that consists of five al phanumeric characters displayed to the right of the special Iogo area.
C. Special regi stration logos, except for the standard di mensi on specified in Paragraph (3) of Subsection B of this section, shall be left to the design di scretion of the di vision, in consultation with the public purpose interest group that requests the special registration plat
D. Standardized special regi stration plates with logos, when authorized by statute for a particul ar public purpose interest group, shall meet the requirements specified in this subsection prior to plate issuance by the di vision. The public purpose interest group, no later than the effective . 149484. 1
date of the authorizing stat ute:
(1) shall provi de evi dence acceptable to the di vision that it will generate a min num number of prepaid appl ications as determined by the di vi si on for the special regi stration plate with logo;
(2) shall provi de a prepayment to the di vision in an amount sufficient to cover the plate and logo cost of the initial order;
(3) shall provi de a sample of the requested artwork desi gn in a format specified by the plate manuf acturer for the specialized Iogo; and
(4) in cases where the authorizing stat ute incl udes revenue-sharing with distribution directed to a particular group or fund, shall show that the recipient is a government al entity or a fund authorized for the use of a government al entity.
E. The di vi si on may promil gate rules for i mpl ementation of the provisions of thi s section."

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
