22	2005 for the purpose of paying for the operating expenses of
23	the Corinne Wolfe children's law center, which operates within
24	the institute of public law of the university of New Mexico

1	(1) salaries and benefits for a director, a
2	staff attorney and administrative support staff; and
3	(2) the provision of training, technical
4	assistance, research assistance and information dissemination
5	in the areas of child abuse, child neglect and juvenile
6	justice. The training, technical assistance, research
7	assistance and information dissemination shall be made
8	available to persons who participate in child abuse
9	proceedings, child neglect proceedings and the juvenile justice
10	system, including volunteers, attorneys and professionals who
11	are not employed by the judicial branch of government.
12	B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
13	at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general
