RELATI NG TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL; PROVI DI NG A THREE-TI ERED CAREER LI CENSI NG FRAMEWORK FOR EDUCATI ONAL ASSI STANTS; PROVI DI NG FOR M NI MUM SALARI ES OF EDUCATI ONAL ASSI STANTS; MAKI NG AN APPROPRI ATI ON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. A new section of the School Personnel Act is enacted to read:
" [ NEW MATERI AL] EDUCATI ONAL ASSI STANTS- - THREE- TI ERED LI CENSI NG FRAMEWORK- - QUALI FI CATI ONS- - M NI MUM SALARI ES. --
A. A level one educational assistant license is a three-year license for begi nning educational assistants that requires an annual intensi ve performance eval uation by a teacher or school administrator and requi red professional devel opment, as determined by the department, for at least . 149700. 1
three full school years bef ore appl ying for another level of license. An applicant for a level one educational assi stant license shall:
(1) be at least ei ght een years of age;
(2) have a high school di plonm or its equi val ent ;
(3) show satisfact ory evi dence of having compl et ed a school district-level orientation; and
(4) pass a department-approved test for par apr of essi onal s.
B. A level two educational assistant license is a ni ne- year license for educational assistants who annually demonstrate essential competency to performtheir duties and who meet professional devel opment requi rements as determined by the department.
C. A level three- A educational assistant license is a ni ne-year license for educational assistants who annually demonstrate essential competency to performtheir duties and who meet professi onal devel opment requi rements as determined by the department. An applicant for a level three- A educational assi stant Iicense shall have completed at least forty-ei ght hours of a bachel or's degree or have an associ ate's degree, ei ther of which includes at least fifteen hours of basic skills, and have practiced as a level two educational assistant for at least three years.

D. A level three-B educational assi stant license is a ni ne-year license for educational assistants who annually demonstrate essential competency to performtheir duties and who meet professi onal devel opment requi rements as determined by the department. An applicant for a level three-B educational assistant license shall hold a bachel or's or hi gher degree and have practiced as a level two educational assistant for at l east three years.
E. The minimusal aries for each licensure l evel are:
(1) for level one educational assi stants, t wel ve thousand dollars (\$12,000);
(2) for level two educational assistants, fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000);
(3) for level three-A educational assistants, t wenty thousand dollars (\$20,000); and
(4) for level three-B educational assi stants, t went $y$-five thousand dollars (\$25,000)."

Section 2. APPROPRI ATI ON. --Ei ght milli on two hundred ten thousand dollars $(\$ 8,210,000)$ is appropriated from the general fund to the state equal ization guarantee distribution for expenditure in fiscal year 2005 to fund the first year of the educational assistant licensure framework and to bring all educational assistants to a mi mumsal ary of twel ve thousand dol I ars $(\$ 12,000)$.
