- 1. On page 2, line 12, strike "An" and insert in lieu thereof "A level one".
- 2. On pages 2 and 3, strike Subsection C in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof:
- "C. Beginning July 1, 2004, an applicant for a level two educational assistant license shall:
 - (1) be at least eighteen years of age;
 - (2) have a high school diploma or its equivalent;
- (3) show satisfactory evidence of having completed a school-district-level orientation; and
- (4) have completed at least forty-eight semester hours of post-secondary non-remedial credit awarded by an accredited college or university that includes at least fifteen semester hours in basic skills and assisting in the classroom.".
- 3. On page 3, line 7, strike "An" and insert in lieu thereof "A level two".
- 4. On page 3, strike Subsection E in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

"E. Beginning July 1, 2004, an applicant for a level three-A educational assistant license shall:

- (1) be at least eighteen years of age;
- (2) have a high school diploma or its equivalent;
- (3) show satisfactory evidence of having completed a school-district-level orientation; and
- (4) have an associate degree from an accredited college or university that includes at least fifteen semester hours in non-remedial degree coursework in basic skills and assisting in the classroom.".
- 5. On page 4, strike Subsection G in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof:
- "G. Beginning July 1, 2004, an applicant for a level three-B educational assistant license shall:
 - (1) be at least eighteen years of age;
 - (2) have a high school diploma or its equivalent;
- (3) show satisfactory evidence of having completed a school-district-level orientation; and
- (4) hold a bachelor's or higher degree from an accredited college or university.".,

and thence referred to the FINANCE COMMITTEE.
