## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT TO EXTEND A PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT NETWORK OF NEW MEXICO SECONDARY SCHOOL ENGLISH TEACHERS TO IMPROVE THE READING, LITERACY AND TECHNOLOGY SKILLS OF THEIR STUDENTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT NETWORK OF ENGLISH
TEACHERS--APPROPRIATION.--

A. One hundred forty-two thousand dollars (\$142,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for expenditure in fiscal years 2004 and 2005 for the purpose of extending a professional development network of New Mexico secondary school English teachers to improve the reading, literacy and technology skills of their

students. The network shall:

- (1) build on the infrastructure of the New Mexico virtual school and make electronic contact between classrooms a reality for a growing number of teachers;
- (2) emphasize using technology to teach to the potential of all children, including children for whom English is a second language; and
- (3) provide teachers with courses in literature and the teaching of writing, creative writing and theater arts that include content that is immediately transportable to their classrooms.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general fund.
- Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
