15	Section 1. MINIMUM MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT RATE
16	A. Notwithstanding any provision of the NMSA 1978
17	to the contrary, the medicaid reimbursement rate established by
18	the human services department for each visit by a medicaid
19	patient to a health care practitioner, including those rates
20	paid under contracts with managed care systems, shall not be
21	less than:
22	(1) seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for fiscal
23	year 2005; and
24	(2) for fiscal year 2006 and each subsequent
25	fiscal year, a rate equal to the rate for the previous fiscal
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year multiplied by the percentage increase in the consumer price index for medical care costs in the preceding calendar year as published by the United States department of labor. As used in this section, "health care В. practitioner" means anyone licensed or certified to provide health care services in this state and includes nurses, physicians, dentists, osteopathic physicians, chiropractors, optometrists, podiatrists, acupuncturists, psychiatrists, psychologists and physical therapists. - 2 -. 150579. 1

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
