16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONThree million dollars
18	(\$3,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New
19	Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year
20	2005 for the Pueblo of Sandia, the Pueblo of Isleta and the
21	middle Rio Grande conservancy district to designate natural
22	habitat and to conserve water to prevent the extinction of the
23	silvery minnow in the Rio Grande from Cochiti dam to Elephant
24	Butte. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the
25	end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general fund.
