25	(\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
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	1	department of health for expenditure in fiscal years 2004 and
	2	2005 for the purpose of establishing and funding a brain injury
	3	medicaid waiver program in cooperation with the human services
	4	department. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
	5	at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general
	6	fund.
