14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONThree million dollars
16	(\$3,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New
17	Mexico gaming control board for expenditure in fiscal year 2004
18	and subsequent fiscal years to upgrade the central system for
19	continuous monitoring of gaming machines at the premises of
20	gaming operator licensees that are racetracks or gaming
21	operator licensees that are nonprofit organizations. Any
22	unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a
23	fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.
24	Section 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
25	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
