46TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2004

AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; CHANGING THE NAME OF THE FILM
ADVISORY BOARD TO THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON FILM AND MEDIA
INDUSTRIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 9-15-4.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
Chapter 97, Section 1) is amended to read:

"9-15-4.1. [~~FILM ADVISORY BOARD~~] GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON
FILM AND MEDIA INDUSTRIES--CREATED--MEMBERSHIP--EXECUTIVE
BOARD.--

A. The [~~"film advisory board"~~] "governor's council
on film and media industries" is created to advise the
department and the governor on ways to promote film production
in New Mexico, assist in the design and implementation of the
department's strategic plan for building a media infrastructure

1 in the state, assist in designing a workforce training program
2 for film production and make recommendations for incentives and
3 funding for these efforts.

4 B. The ~~[film advisory board]~~ governor's council on
5 film and media industries shall be composed of no more than
6 thirty members appointed by the governor for four-year
7 staggered terms; provided that the initial appointments shall
8 be made so that one-half of the members shall be appointed for
9 two-year terms and one-half of the members shall be appointed
10 for four-year terms. Terms shall expire on January 1.

11 C. From the membership of the ~~[film advisory board]~~
12 governor's council on film and media industries, the governor
13 shall appoint a seven-member "executive board". At least five
14 members of the executive board shall have experience in some
15 aspect of film production. The executive board shall:

16 (1) with the approval of the secretary, create
17 subcommittees of the ~~[film advisory board]~~ governor's council
18 on film and media industries and name the chairmen of those
19 subcommittees;

20 (2) coordinate activities of the subcommittees
21 and the ~~[film advisory board]~~ governor's council on film and
22 media industries; and

23 (3) develop recommendations pertaining to the
24 charges of the ~~[film advisory board]~~ governor's council on film
25 and media industries for the consideration of the ~~[film~~

1 ~~advisory board~~] governor's council on film and media
2 industries.

3 D. The governor shall name the chairman of the
4 [~~film advisory board~~] governor's council on film and media
5 industries, who shall serve as the chairman of the executive
6 board. The [~~film advisory board~~] governor's council on film
7 and media industries may elect such other officers as it deems
8 necessary. The [~~film advisory board~~] governor's council on
9 film and media industries shall meet at the call of the
10 chairman, at least quarterly. Members of the [~~film advisory~~
11 ~~board~~] governor's council on film and media industries may
12 receive per diem and mileage for travel within New Mexico as
13 provided in the Per Diem and Mileage Act, but shall receive no
14 other compensation, perquisite or allowance.

15 E. Staff for the [~~film advisory board~~] governor's
16 council on film and media industries shall be provided by the
17 department.

18 F. The [~~film advisory board~~] governor's council on
19 film and media industries shall report to the department, the
20 governor and the legislature by December 1 of each year on its
21 activities and recommendations."

22 Section 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION--REFERENCES IN LAW.--All
23 references in law to the film advisory board shall be deemed to
24 be references to the governor's council on film and media
25 industries.

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
