## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT TO SUPPORT DROPOUT PREVENTION, LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND FAMILY EDUCATION PROGRAMS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One million three hundred eighty-one thousand eight hundred seventy-five dollars (\$1,381,875) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for expenditure in fiscal years 2004 and 2005 to support a dropout prevention, leadership development and family education program plan that also provides professional teacher training, development of academic and culturally based language arts and social science curricula for at-risk Hispanic teenagers and family orientation and goal planning initiatives. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance

remaining at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general fund.
