16	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONOne million two hundred
17	thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) is appropriated from the general
18	fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year
19	2005 to increase the number of pharmacy technicians and
20	pharmacy services available in primary health care clinics, in
21	rural and medically underserved areas of the state, pursuant to
22	the Rural Primary Health Care Act. Any unexpended or
23	unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2005
24	shall revert to the general fund.
