AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; CREATING THE WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH INSTITUTE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- Section 1. WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH INSTITUTE CREATED --PURPOSE. --
- The "water resources research institute" is created and shall be a division of New Mexico state university.
- Participating institutions associated with the institute shall be New Mexico state university, the university of New Mexico, New Mexico institute of mining and technology, New Mexico highlands university, eastern New Mexico university and western New Mexico university. The purposes of the institute are to:

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 2005 for the water resources research institute to increase research in water conservation, planning and management. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
