AN ACT

FOR THE WELFARE REFORM OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

RELATING TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE; CREATING THE CRIME OF MALICIOUS EXPOSURE OF A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR DISCLOSING THE LOCATION OF A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER; ENACTING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Crimes Against Household Members Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] MALICIOUS EXPOSURE OF A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER.--

- A. Malicious exposure of a domestic violence shelter consists of the disclosure of the location of a domestic violence shelter by a person with the intent of:
- (1) encouraging or enabling physical harm of the domestic violence shelter or its occupants; or
