I request that the following capital outlay projects be funded:

• to the public education department

eighty-two thousand seven hundred dollars (\$82,700) for educational technology in Sombra del Monte elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000) to update infrastructure and purchase communication lines, ports, analog cards and phones for Sandia high school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for educational technology in Del Norte high school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

seventy-two thousand sixty-nine dollars (\$72,069) for educational technology in Zuni elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to upgrade the network with switches and laptops at Sandia high school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county;

one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) to construct two portable classrooms for Osuna elementary school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county:
